**Country overview:**

The Netherlands has a population of around 18.3 million in 2025. The total fertility rate (TFR) is low—about 1.43 children per woman in 2023, and recent data (2024) suggest it remains around 1.4–1.48. The public healthcare system covers maternal and reproductive care, child benefits (through the Sociale Verzekeringsbank (SVB)) for families with children under 18. Mental health services are accessible via the regular health insurance system, but waiting times and regional variation exist. For child benefit and family support, you apply via SVB and receive benefits if living/working in the Netherlands. In the Netherlands the emergency helpline is 112
