Country overview

Slovenia has an estimated population of about 2.12 million as of 2025. The total fertility rate is around 1.50–1.60 children per woman, indicating a below-replacement level of childbearing. Access to reproductive and sexual health care is a legal right: pregnant women, contraception, termination of pregnancy and infertility treatment are included under the system of state-paid services (though not all treatments are fully covered). The country also offers generous family benefits: maternity leave of 105 days at 100% benefit, paternity leave of 30 days at 100% benefit, and parental leave of 130 days per parent.
